Epic: then and now...

One of the most amazing parts of ministry that I have gotten to experience has been with Epic, the Asian-American ministry of Campus Crusade. Ever since I got involved with Campus Crusade at UC Davis twelve years ago, I was challenged to start an Epic Movement on the campus. I never even thought I would be seen as Asian, being as mixed and dark-skinned as I am, but God did use me to start a ministry that forever impacted my life.

As a sophomore in 1999, I started leading an Asian-American women's Bible study. It was scary for me as I was only 19 years old and wasn't sure what would really come of it. There were two girls that came each time - which seems good right? But they were two DIFFERENT girls each time! Eventually, there were six girls coming consistenly. Some ended up leading other younger Bible studies in the following years

and after I graduated, Epic started reaching men and expanded to over 100 people! The movement there b

I look back at my experiences with Epic as a student and see how much it has shaped the way I reach out to students especially of Asian-American background. I am very passionate about using the culture I was raised in to relate with others and present the gospel in a way they'd understand.

Since my fiancé Nich has been serving with Epic for the past 4 years, it seems like it'd be an easy decision for me to return back to Epic as well. But that meant leaving Hawaii - the people, my friendships, my home church, etc. It was one of the most difficult decisions I've ever had to make, but as we sought God and talked through it for weeks,

we've decided to both serve with Epic in the Orange County/Long Beach area starting this fall!

My role will transition out of being a campus director to campus staff but like in HI, most of my time will go to sharing my faith on campus and discipiling Asian-American students. Nich and I will still need your support! Nich's support is not enough to support the both of us—we must
