It's true - living in the heart of San Francisco with 44 students and staff was stretching and growing. It was difficult living among many homeless and people in need - we didn't know how to help. We even witnessed a couple fist fighting outside of our hostel. Tricia called the cops for help. But the question that lingered was:

"How do we bring Jesus to a city that seems so far away from Him?"

Nich and I both had a handful of students to disciple on a one-on-one basis. They worked during the day, mostly at volunteer positions like the Salvation Army though, since it's so hard to find summer jobs. But we would meet them on their day off or on the weekend. A lot of the time was spent processing

through what it was like for them to live in the city and share their faith in the midst of their workplaces and new environment. We wrestled through feelings of tiredness, failure, lack of faith and lies that Satan really tried to make them believe.
