Greetings from the Bay Area! We're here this month continuing to share our ministry in Japan. By God's grace, we've seen a lot of progress recently and are now at 80% of our monthly financial goal! Pending Jungshin's citizenship and our Japanese visa applications, we hope to finish support-raising and leave for Osaka by January 2012.

However, from the start, God has made it clear that our time in America is about much more than finances: he also has things he wants to teach us and people he wants us to minister to while we're here. In the past month, for example, we've had some great opportunities to meet new Japanese friends as we travel

Last month, I had the privilege of speaking at a small Japanese church in my hometown. To be honest, it was a little nerve-wracking to preach in Japanese after not doing it for more than a year. But I think everyone left encouraged to pray for the salvation of Japan and work to reach the Japanese people living in their area.

After arriving in Northern California, we also had the chance to meet Nobu, an Osaka University student doing an exchange program at Berkeley. 
Please pray for God's provision of our remaining financial needs, and for his guidance over every person in America that he still wants us to meet. We're almost there!
