It was a muggy Friday afternoon at Kobe University, the last day on campus for our short-term mission teams. Not finding many students to talk with, we sat down in the shade to rest. As the class next door finished, out walked "N," a friendly exchange student who had also studied before in Korea. We connected easily over our experience of living in Seoul and our shared love for languages.

The next day was a BBQ the team had planned with their host church. At the last minute, N decided to go, and he enjoyed himself so much, he decided to come to church on Sunday, too! Because N comes from a closed country, it was his first time attending a Christian service. But he was visibly moved as he listened intently throughout.


