- Part of my new role includes opportunities to develop partnerships outside of CCC with like-minded churches and organizations. How fun to work together with other believers to build His Kingdom!
- I am still responsible to develop my full financial support as I have for the past ten years on staff. I'm excited to continue to minister alongside you, my faithful team of ministry partners!

I'm very encouraged as I process the significance of these responsibilities in light of how God is working. I appreciate your prayers as I transition and trust God to provide for me. **Here are some specific needs I'd love for you to cover in prayer:**

Housing: That I can find summer housing in Orlando and a more permanent place to live beginning in September.

Move: Wisdom regarding how best to move the rest of my belongings from Boston later this summer.

Friendships: That God would provide key friendships outside of CCC for me in the Orlando area.

Ministry Partners: In order to report on time to my new assignment on June 21st, I must be back to a level of 100% of my monthly financial support –there's quite a gap right now, so I pray God connects me with new friends that I might partner with in the next few weeks. ☺
