

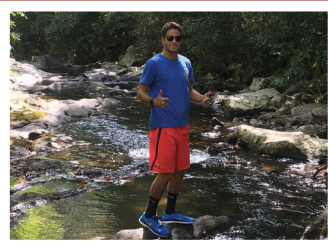
HAPPY NEW YEAR
