After three attempts the well in Lacienne could not be drilled. Too many large boulders were deep in the ground of the fruit tree land even for the "big rig" that was brought in. It was frustrating to concede; the fruit tree farm could not have a well. Disappointed the men gathered; perplexed they exchanged ideas while discussing options. *Meanwhile*, the well driller surveyed the area and identified a better place to drill. The problem was

*However*, God was moving. When Pastor Wiljean called me to inform me that the "big rig" would not break through the boulders I literally was sitting at my desk tearing into an envelope which fell open a \$5000 check for general fund donation to use at our discretion!

The Lacienne well is fully functioning now and is producing water on **land owned** by the agricultural committee. This land is actually the best location for future crop expansion and for the fruit tree nursery. God sees and knows perfectly all things, in all places, at all times.
