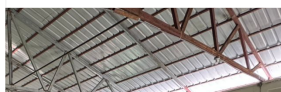


HAPPY NEW YEAR

Wednesday nights

Ministry leaders and supporters of ministry understand the biblical mandate of discipleship making.

Think about this... IF you are a Christ surrendered parent you know how blessed would you be to have your son engaging in lengthy conversations with retired Pastors (white baseball hat) and other God-fearing men who are investing their time and wisdom, speaking Life and encouragement into your son.

Think about this... If you're a man who grew up without a dad, or a poor example of one, you never understood the significance of having a Godly mentor in your life. It's truly eye-opening to witness a 45-year old man passionately expressing his deep appreciation for the guidance and support of a Godly men guiding him. Hearing him express what he now sees. Making disciples takes on many forms. This is what happens Wednesday nights under the lights at Shade Tree Ministry.

Thursday & Friday mornings

As intended, the morning gatherings of the mighty men of God have become increasingly dominated by an older age group. This demographic of older men often have unique spiritual needs that may go unnoticed in most active and growing congregations, and in some cases not going to any church. What they truly require is a place where they can listen and be heard. They also wrestle together the Word, not sports or politics, but about the word of God and what it commands of us. This becomes the lens through which we interpret our shared experiences and navigate the many trials of this stage of life. They are encouraged to be a mentor to the next generation.



Facts and figures do not describe the growth in a man's deeper walk with Christ, time to reason together does

- Over 50 men have attended more than 3 times this year
- Friday mornings
 - Average attendance 17 men
 - Average length of time, 2.5 hours
 - Q four had on average 2 new guys each month
 - Max capacity of the deck 25, reached 3 times
- Wednesday nights
 - Started October
 - Average attendance 18 (5 over 50yrs old, 13, 20-30 yrs old)
 - Unexpected niche, men in their 30's and 40's with no father figure in their lives, looking for guidance
 - Average length of time, 2.5 hours
- Brian meets with a handful of men one-on-one
