1 Children camp(550)came for one week, all the Churches kids presented in the bid events,80 children accepted Jesus as personal savior.

2 Mission trip at Hinche(200) church members participated in this events. We preached door to door,house to house (5000)thousands people heard the words, and we made evangelical crusade each night so many people came to hear the word of God. praise God we have had very good results. 400 accepted Jésus as Lord, believing in God.

3 The great miracle happen in the same time, we built the church in the town. we rent a land for \$
