entire ministry. While plans are being prepared for the school and medical clinic, the land will be used to

grow a high protein fountain grass to feed goats. These goats are on a 40 acre parcel of land close to the church and they are being raised to support another Christian ministry!



LACIENNE (also know as Hinche) Lacienne is a small village outside of Hinche and is the actual location of Open Door Church. Lacienne is the village where Pastor Wiljean was born and where Pastor Oclane was his childhood Pastor. From now on I'm going to use the name Lacienne (La-C-N).

Updates...

WELL ~ We started to drill the irrigation well (on the tree farm) and ran into trouble. Actually, ran into huge boulders! A bigger rig is needed to do the drilling here and will begin the first week in February. Keep this team and project in prayer.

FARM ~ The agriculture committee have been very busy and industrious. They now have 4 separate tracks of land in production ranging from 1 to 8 acres. They have registered with the government to sell produce commercially and are also working with other farmers further outside the area to build a network of

commercial growers.





FRUIT TREE

FARM ~ THM is making steady progress in launching the fruit tree farm. Praise God with us! He has brought forth a general donation



and THM has designated it for this land purchase. Open Door church will purchase and own the land for the tree farm! Coffee, mango, papaya, banana, and cocoa trees... grow Haiti grow!

FRUIT TREE NURSERY ~ Land has been identified for the fruit tree nursery. It is adjacent to the fruit tree farm. Grow trees in the nursery and plant *some* on the farm. Simple and effective. More news to come as we hear back from the land owner.
