Construction of the second chicken house is complete! 500 more birds will be added to flock. How exciting it is to actually see how the school and orphanage at open Door will be supported in the future. Thank you Lighthouse team for working so hard to raise the funds needed.

What do chickens and corn have to do with each



other? Ok, anyone who grew up on a farm can't answer, but if you're like me, I didn't really know or care :-) Well... chickens eat corn, lots of corn. So when corn

prices increase like they have been this year, our profit margin drops on poultry. Shall we stop growing poultry, NO!

We grow corn as well! Pastor Wiljean is very excited about growing corn on Open Door property. If corn prices increase, great, if they drop, more profitable on poultry. I spoke with a company in Haiti that will buy as much corn as we can produce. Open Door can only produce so much, lets grow more.

Spread the opportunity. Pastor Wiljean will spread the word in the village to all farmers that there is a buyer for corn. Each farmer is independent, growing his own corn to sell. Profits

from his labor, and gives a percentage in return for irrigation service. Lack of water is the greatest deterrent to farmers. Idle



land and manpower, which there is unfortunately plenty, can now be put into action. We have land, labor and a buyer for corn. We need farmers! We need your expertise!

- portable watering tank to water small farms




