The foundation asked us to construct a comprehensive agricultural development plan that **completely supports** the seminary for their **prayerful consideration**. No commitment at this point. The foundation's maximum investment **250k**.

Through our Haitian partners, THM has hired two men who are charged with building a team writing the business plan and together we shall refine when Brian is in Haiti next month. Brian will visit all the proposed plots of land they identified for purchase.
