They will be visiting the Hinche farm in April where we will discuss options to buy (in country) from us!

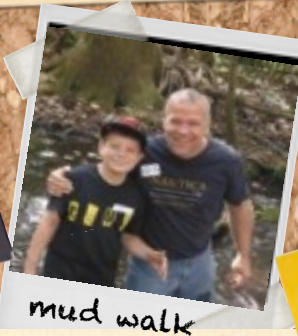
Aid to enterprise in action!

This has been a hard lesson for me to learn over the past 10 years. Haiti is filled with loving traps.

Imagine, you're living as a recipient of charity, you're not fulfilling the creative capacity that God has endowed us with; that creative capacity sits idle. At the deepest level, this is what's so inadequate about the traditional response to poverty with perpetual charity. It kills the spirit of the entrepreneur who would be creating and providing. In our country, Christian men like S. Truett Cathy, James C. Penney and John D. Rockefeller **created**. Their creativity revolutionized industry, created countless jobs and invested millions into building the church.

Equip Haitian entrepreneurs **to create**.
