God's long suffering ~ In Haiti voodoo is practiced. Witch doctors with the most influence bring their customers in for healing under the biggest trees. The bigger the tree the bigger the crowds. Demon worshipers also gathered around the trees at night for satanic praise and worship. Sadly, huge trees are used as **symbols of power** in voodoo.

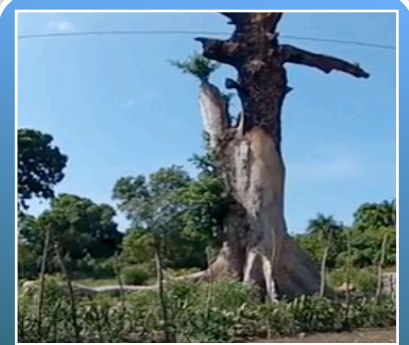
God moves ~ Several years ago, God provided Pastor Payot's church with land right across the road from one of the **BIGGEST** trees in Caracol. While the church land sat idle satan was worshiped under that big tree across the road... until **God moved**. Last year with a direct lightning strike to that tree the voodoo symbol of evil burned and the evil-doers scattered. Pastor Payot puts it like this, "It was the LORDS way to let people know that only GOD deserves to be worshiped", said Pastor Payot. "Not a tree, not the devil, not a man, but **GOD ALONE** is to be worshiped." The time was right for God's house to be built in Caracol.



Fast forward one year - the footers for the house of worship have been poured, and in October a team with THM will join the work and pour a concrete floor.

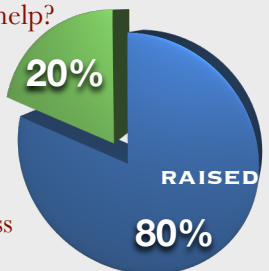


Family monthly support update:
