We sent a team of twelve students to Gothenberg, Sweden, to serve with Cru's Every Initiative, a ministry started by Liberty students! The team shared the gospel with students, helped to continue to forge partnerships with local churches, and served the influx of refugees in the name of Christ.



### FLORIDA

We have lost count of how many times Andrew has been to this conference! (Over 20) This year Andrew was the Program Director and played a huge role in coordinating with speakers, coaching the emcee and making sure the meetings ran smoothly. We continue to send students to Panama City Beach, FL because it continues to be one of the most effective strategies in connecting lost students to the gospel, as well as eliciting vision and faith for our believing students! This year the team of seventeen were part of the week where 66 people gave their lives to Christ! It was also lots of fun as you can see an example of in the picture below.



### DOMINICAN REPUBLIC

Partnering with Filter of Hope, our team of eleven went to Punta Plata, DR to install water filters in communities without access to clean water, and share the gospel with those they come in contact with. The team were able to hand out 32 water filters, have 62 gospel conversations, and saw 16 people place their faith in Christ!!
