Our summer Bible study was a great success! We had an average of 8-10 students coming weekly for food, fellowship and fun. Using Cru's Thrive "How to Study the Bible" course, we taught students how to think of the 66 books in the Bible as one grander narrative that tells the story of Jesus. We are very proud of our students for being brave and tackling this challenge! Several of our students, who were originally reluctant to read ANYTHING out loud, ended the time not only reading selections of Scripture out loud, but also PRAYING out loud! This is an enormous developmental step as it demonstrates a feeling of safety and acceptance in regards to our community. We ended our time with a game/celebration night playing What Do You Meme, foosball, air hockey, and a friendly game of knockout (see the pre-carnage photo below!).

With 25 students going to places all around the world including 10 of those on the DR trip that we told you about last month, we far exceeded the total of 13 students that went in the summer of 2019. We have students in Virginia Beach, Ocean City, Yellowstone, North Africa, and Costa Rica.

Cru Summer missions are designed to give students leadership and growth opportunities. We were delighted to find out that Evan was chosen to be the Student Summer Mission Director!

One of the locations we were blessed to send students to was North Africa, a longstanding partnership that we've had — you may recall that Jena led a team

Imagine the shock of our team when one day, as Sam and her team were meeting North African students, they connected with a girl whose best friend had received Christ through our digital evangelism efforts from Lynchburg?!?! What a sweet gift from the Lord for our students to be able to see the fruit of those seeds sown!
