One highlight was being able to connect with a couple who had been on the Tokyo Vision Trip team last year who are now serving full time there! Japan is the second largest unreached people group in the world -- statistically speaking, there is one missionary for every 62,000+ people. SI Tokyo (the name of the Cru movement) has a vision to see 2% of the population reached with the gospel by 2040.
