

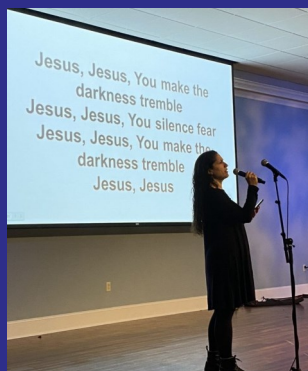


Ministry Update for the Browns
