CRU SPRING BREAK: THE NEW "BIG BREAK!"

When we heard that Big Break was being retired last spring, we were sad. It provided an opportunity for students to experience deep fellowship, take steps of faith, and bring back what they learned to campus.

So when a group of campus directors decided to continue the PCB tradition with a smaller version of the conference, we joyfully volunteered to be Program Directors! Throughout the past few months, we diligently worked to create a fun and spiritually edifying conference, along with another staff. We also emceed the whole conference! Besides the obvious fun elements of awkward games and singing onstage (we even had a couple from PVCC get engaged!), it was a joy to train up students to share their faith. The results of the trip were remarkable: 3 students at the conference accepted Christ! After hearing a message on missions many students began asking God if he is calling them to go. Four students have now applied to go on Cru Summer Mission! During a men's time we had numerous guys share struggles and hard things that have happened in the past that they had never shared with anyone before. There was a ton of healing that night and in the days that followed. It was amazing!



Along with our schools and 10 others, there were 250 staff and students. Besides evangelism, the students were able to partner with Gain (Cru's humanitarian arm) to help provide clean up and relief from Hurricane Michael.
