AMAZING GROWTH ON SPRING BREAK

On March 19th Andrew headed up a trip of students that drove from Boston to Panama City Beach, FL for the Big Break conference. The trip down took over 30 hours and an accident and a flat tire made it seem even longer. After seeing what God did in the lives of the students during the week, I have no doubt that it was all worth it.

Big Break is a conference for students involved with Campus Crusade from around the US that gives students the opportunity to share their faith in Christ with people on the beach. There were also daily morning and evening sessions where the students got to hear from excellent speakers and worship together. One speaker, Roger Hershey (listen to his talks: www.rogerhershey.com), challenged the students to surrender their rights to God. In other words, to give God control of every area of their lives. The students also spent an afternoon preparing meals for those in Haiti that have been affected by the earthquake. Through the combined efforts of those at the conference 323,000 meals were packed!

Some were in tears as

One highlight for me involves May, a student from Bunker Hill CC who really gave her week over to God to be used to share with others about having a personal relationship with Him. On the last night while the other Boston students were riding go-karts, May decided she wanted to go out one last time and share her faith with people. May led someone to Christ that night. What an amazing experience for her to have during her spring break! It is one she will never forget.
