PARTNERSHIP: CRU AND LIBERTY

On May 10, 2018 a historic meeting took place between Cru staff and the Sending and Service Office at Liberty (LU Send and LU Serve). Here are a few developments from those meetings:

- There are plans in place to try to connect the nearly 100,000 LU online students to Cru ministries wherever these individuals are located around the US.
- We are working on developing two signature opportunities for Liberty students to participate in missions with Cru. The domestic opportunity will likely be a week long Spring Break trip to Philadelphia to do holistic ministry. The international opportunity will be to launch ministries in North Africa or Sweden.
- Liberty is fully supportive of our local ministry efforts and has helped us to become an official recognized group. We are working on establishing greater partnership with the domestic arm of LU to enable us to reach more students with the Gospel in Lynchburg.
