WINTER CONFERENCE AND....WE'RE BACK!

The spring semester is back in full swing! Our family spent the new year at Cru Winter Conference in Baltimore with 40 students (and our ten person staff team) from UVA, PVCC, CVCC and Liberty. The conference was an incredible time of worship and recommitment to the Lord. Our days were filled with powerful talks from gifted speakers, reunions with our Dominican Republic team from this summer, and different seminars covering everything from addiction to full time overseas missionary work.

Our favorite time of this conference is always the Pledge. This is a time set aside during the final new year's eve meeting where students can do business with God and consider whether or not they are willing to go, do, say or give anything for the sake of His kingdom. Usually a handful of our students will sign the Pledge, but this year we had 45 staff and students sign the pledge!!! Students can indicate if the Lord has impressed anything upon them that warrant steps of faith. Below are some of the highlights of their decisions:

- One student trusted Christ for the first time!
- 16 students want to go on a summer mission with Cru
- 9 students want to give a year of their life to the Lord on mission.

On the final night we had students get together to share about what they learned. It was exciting time to hear what God had done in their lives. I received an encouragement note that was likely the best I've ever received. Maggie, one of our PVCC leaders that went to the DR with us wrote:

If it wasn't for God choosing to use you in Cville, I would be a very different person. So thank you, thank you, thank you for being obedient to that. You make such a big difference and are good at making people feel special."
