FALL RETREAT 2015



Fall Retreat 2015 was a huge success! Held at Camp Watermarks in Scottsville, VA, we saw a record-breaking 102 UVA and PVCC students attend!

This was the first time that Cru at PVCC was officially part of the Fall Retreat. Our main speaker was Dr. Keith Johnson, the director of theological education for Cru and a guest professor of systematic theology at Reformed Theological Seminary. Dr. Johnson gave a message series about the "Music of the Gospel" — the premise being that as believers we are often doing the "dance steps" of the Christian life without experiencing the music that is meant to motivate the dance steps, the good news of Jesus Christ. Students were truly challenged



by their own tendency to go on autopilot in terms of loving and serving God. As an academic, Dr. Johnson spoke the heart language of the majority of our students and was able to have a platform to challenge them on a level that spoke to their culture. Though it rained the ENTIRE weekend, our students and staff managed to have a great time playing slip and slide kickball, a Color Me Rad capture the flag game in a corn maze, flying off waterslides into the lake and being propelled off a blob into the lake. One of the highlights for all was the Friday night variety show, kicked off by the staff men singing as a Boy Band. Students sang, told stories, danced and broke bricks with their bear hands — who knew that our student body was so talented!?



On Saturday night we had a corn hole tournament where each student had a partner and dressed up in costumes. It was a lot of fun!
