## BACK TO SCHOOL!



It's that time of year again! Students have once again flooded our city, breathing new life and excitement into all of Boston. This year there are 300,000 students expected to embrace Boston as their place of residence during college. You may wonder how we

might endeavor to reach such a massive scope with the gospel. How do we put into practice our motto "building spiritual movements everywhere, so that everyone knows someone who truly follows Jesus?" What is our strategic plan?

### 1) Mobilize leaders.

At the end of August, we had a welcome back leaders meeting for Umass Boston students where we connected with students that share in our mission and vision. We asked them to share their hopes and dreams of what God could do on their campuses and prayed to that effect. We helped them come up with some objectives and a schedule.

### 2) Connecting with new students.

This fall we will do several tables where we do "giveaways" — we set up tables at activities fairs and give away water bottles, books, ice cream, etc., in exchange for a spiritual survey. If the student indicates that they would like to know more about having a personal relationship with God or more about Real Life on campus, we will follow up with them, make them aware of the many things we have happening on and off campus, and invite them to join us.

### 3) Life Groups and discipleship.

Students who have revealed themselves to be faithful, available and teachable facilitate Life Group Bible

studies on campus. We, in turn, disciple those students, offering assistance, input and encouragement.

### 4) Creating Transformational Community.

In addition to being on campus, we offer many opportunities to connect off-campus. As many of our students are at public schools without dorms, this can be a critical component in creating and sustaining fellowship. This fall we have our weekly Citywide meeting at historic Park Street Church; a three hour Boat Cruise with food, games and dancing; the Fall Retreat in New Hampshire on beautiful Lake Winnepesaukee; and an apple-picking trip. In addition to these, we also invite students over every other week for a home-cooked meal and fellowship. Please join us in praying for God's love to invade the hearts and souls of all the students we come in contact with!
