The separate men's and women's \*ministries\* are vital to our students to developing as men and women distinctive and critical in the propagation of the kingdom of God. This past month, Kaleh has been active with many events.

February 2-3 saw the longstanding Kaleh Winter Retreat, an overnight where women come together to worship, sit under great teaching, and listen to "Fourth Year Wisdom," a section of the time where our fourth years share what the Lord has been teaching them over the years — a way of them leaving a spiritual legacy.
