We had all six colleges and one high school represented (no small logistical task!), and a representative of each got to share how the Lord is moving on their respective campus and how we could be praying. Pastor James Hobson of Hill City Community Church spoke on the urgency of following Jesus and living out a vibrant faith before a seeking world. One highlight was being able to debut a worship song we had written as a staff team after seeing five students come to Christ through our Fall Retreat. The song is called "Twice As Much" and has a refrain based off of Psalm 65:8.

*We may need to write a new song!* Every week, we go to Central Virginia Community College with students who are interested in learning how to share their faith. We briefly train them, model for them, and then encourage them to go out sharing. We have had the privilege of training hundreds of students this semester through an opportunity with an Evangelism class at Liberty. Often we are privileged to connect with students and engage them in spiritual conversation, but last week we saw FIVE men and women make decisions for Christ! Below is a picture of the three women—dual enrolled high school students who we are connecting with Cru students at their schools. What a privilege and joy! Andrew got to share the Gospel with UB who also accepted Christ. Andrew asked him afterwards how confident he was in his salvation between 1-100%. "100%" he said as we high fived in agreement!
