

THIS IS HOW WE DO CRU!



MISSIONS NIGHT AT UVA

Every year we have a Missions Night to give our students exposure to what Cru is doing around the world in order to fulfill the Great Commission. He highlighted three regional partnerships we send to: East Asia (a closed country in Asia), Sam's Place (a closed country in North Africa), and Puerto Rico.
