Unexpected Blessing #1

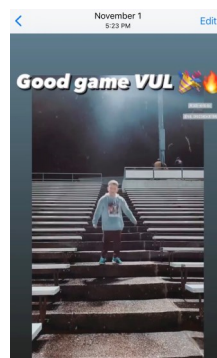
