On April 9th at the Doubletree Hotel in Charlottesville we held our 2nd annual Vision Dinner. There were 135 in attendance which included UVA faculty, alumni, parents, current students and other ministry partners. This is always a highlight for us as staff as we are able to showcase the work that the Lord is doing at UVA and PVCC.

The message for the evening was given by Dr. Sonia Cabell, research scientist at UVA, and powerful stories were shared by students from UVA and PVCC. We are pleased to report that for the funding we requested for ministry at both schools for next year we exceeded our goal of \$80,000. The funds that were raised were not for personal support of our current staff but for the ministry at each campus. Dear Friend,

This summer, our whole family will have the exciting opportunity of serving the Lord overseas. Andrew and I will be directing and leading a team of 19 to Santo Domingo, the capital of the Dominican Republic, to share God's love with college students. For five weeks, we will do outreach and build relationships, mainly at Universidad Autónoma de Santo Domingo (UASD), where many students have been eager to hear about Jesus in the past. We'll also help out the missionaries and the Cru movement that is already there. We have an opportunity to do some pioneering as well. We will be going to San Pedro for one week as well with the hope of starting new Cru ministries on the campuses in that city. This is our family's first trip overseas and we are thrilled to have an opportunity to be serving the Lord together!

The expenses of the trip come to about \$7,000, including travel, housing, and food. **Would you prayerfully consider partnering with me in reaching university students in the DR through a special gift of \$100, \$200, \$500 or some other amount?** Of course, whatever the Lord calls you to give is the right amount.
