FALL RETREAT 2009

Our fall retreat was an opportunity for approximately 200 students to get away from campus life in order to experience fellowship, the beauty of Lake Winnepesaukee, and the challenge of taking Christ to their campus. We had a wonderful time connecting with students from the 20+ campuses represented at the retreat.

One of the highlights for Jena was a 7am prayer time she led on Saturday. She expected low attendance, as it was not on the schedule and an optional meeting (and at 7am!), but was excited by the **12 students** that came to pray! There was spontaneous worship, tears of confession and an overall heart of worship and adoration. Students in Boston are yearning for God! It was such an encouragement to see this kind of passion for God in our students' lives.
