## RADIATE 2014

Praise the Lord for a life changing, spirit-filled Radiate Conference! 24 students from UVA attended this year, held in historic Washington D.C. The conference was an incredible time for our students to grow in deeper relationship with the Lord and with one another. There were many highlights for us, but here are the TOP FIVE:

### 1. Students worshipping in the New Year.

There were over 1,000 students at the conference and on New Year's Eve, staff and students celebrated with a massive dance party that evolved into a night of worship, where the students honored God as their first act of 2015.

### 2. Incredible speakers that challenged the faith of both staff and students alike.

One of the speakers is a personal favorite of ours. James White, was the keynote speaker at the 2007 Northeast Winter Conference where Jena surrendered her life to Christ, (Andrew also developed a friendship with him over the years as he was a frequent speaker at conferences we attended). Heather Holleman (Class of '97), a favorite speaker among UVA women, also spoke about making Jesus first in one's life in an entertaining and significant way.



### 3. Openness to evangelism.

All of our students were willing to go to GWU during the day of outreach to meet people and engage them in spiritual conversation.

**4. International options for UVA students.** Through exposure to our seven international partnerships through the "World Café," a room dedicated to promoting summer missions and stint opportunities with Cru, several of our students made decisions to go overseas.

### 5. Signing the Pledge.

Matt Mikalatos, one of the conference speakers, challenged our students to pledge to go, do, give, and say anything the Lord wanted them to. Students had the option of signing a card and placing it on the stage. 750 students signed the pledge at the conference including 13 from UVA! Of those 750: 24 accepted Christ, 105 committed to spending a year on mission, and 220 committed to spending a summer.
