## SAN PEDRO



One of most impactful times for us in the DR was a five day mission-within-a-mission trip. Our US team of 19, two local Vida Estudiantil (the name for Cru in the DR) staff and five Dominican students went to Universidad Centro del Este (UCE) in order to launch a Cru ministry there. We used a key volunteer strategy rather than just sharing the gospel (although we saw 5 people come to Christ in San Pedro!) and just tried to identify Christians on campus all week and challenge them to consider leading Cru. We had a huge informational meeting at the end of the week where we invited all of the contacts we had made during the week. More than 40 students were in attendance at the meeting, and leaders emerged and committed to leading and being distance coached. We are grateful for the opportunity to help facilitate the start of this ministry, and feel great joy knowing that history will be changed in the city of San Pedro because of the gospel taking root in the minds and hearts of these future leaders.

What an incredible time of seeing the Lord work, growing in our faith and growing in community we all had as a team of 19 during the five weeks we served in the Dominican Republic! Our project verse was Romans 8:37-39, and we saw Scripture come to life as we conquered fear of sharing faith in Spanish, scorching 90 degree weather (where we wore jeans daily, which is a cultural norm there) and overcoming our entitlements such as clean tap water. In spite of our team only having one fluent Spanish speaker, in spite of four of our students never having even been on a plane, let alone out of the country...we were blessed to see **OVER THIRTY MEN AND WOMEN BEGIN THEIR RELATIONSHIP WITH CHRIST!** We are living proof that miracles happen every day, because only a work of the Holy Spirit could have enabled us to see the results that we saw with our own eyes. Dominicans are hungry for and open to the gospel. The harvest is plentiful!

A personal ministry highlight for Andrew happened in a college classroom. After meeting a girl who was already a Christian, she insisted that Andrew come to her English class to preach. Andrew agreed and
