Calvary Chapel Chattanooga Week

Every year Calvary Chapel Chattanooga (CCC) sends a missions team from their congregation to help us do ministry.

On one of the days at Poly High after school, we found an empty campus. For some reason, all the students had vanished! Trusting in God, we began to prayerfully search for students. One group that we sent (Susan who is on staff and two students) eventually found three kids: Sebastian, Jesus, and David. After offering them free pizza, they agreed to stay and play Solarium (a card game) with us. The purpose of Solarium is to help kids share their stories with the goal of sharing the Gospel. After almost an hour, all three students made the decision to accept Jesus as their Lord and Savior! While Susan could have shared, she chose to allow our kids (Scotty and Jacob) to share the Gospel with the students.

This is only one of many amazing stories of what God did this week! At the end of the week we had visited eight schools, spoken to 996 students, and 308 indicated a decision to accept Jesus as their Lord and Savior! Thank you for your prayers!



FVHS Springfest

Over the last year, we have been praying for an opportunity to evangelize on the campus of FVHS. At the end of March, our prayers were answered in a club fair called "Springfest". Cru set up a station offering free Boba tea to engage with students. The purpose of the station was to challenge students to identify what their peers and themselves "thirsted" for. In response, we shared the gospel using John 4:13-14.

I was amazed that so many of our students volunteered to share Jesus with their peers. We had 111 students go through our station; and 51 students indicated a decision to follow Jesus!

In one of the groups I brought through, they all responded with a desire to know Jesus. After sharing, Jason and Amy prayed to receive Christ right there in the quad of their high school campus! Since then, Amy has been faithful to attend every lunch and night Cru meeting. She is even bringing her friends to the events! She said, "I love coming to Cru because it teaches me what it truly means to be a Christian. It is a very open environment where I am free to ask any question."
