

Ministry in a Pandemic: Our "new" Normal

During the week of March 9th, the last 4 school days before school was canceled, we held evangelistic rallies at eight of our schools – sharing the Gospel with approximately 1,600 students! Out of those, we were able to connect with 1,300 personally, follow up with regarding the message, and invite them to various virtual events! Because we can no longer meet in person, min-



istry is now conducted through an online communication platform called "Discord". Discord enables our students to text, call, and video each other! We host bible studies, virtual workouts, movie nights, and game nights. We have had several successful outreach events where we have shared the Gospel with new students!
