Every night, I just sat there smiling and sometimes crying knowing the reason that this is happening is because of Jesus and the obedience of the team to sacrifice what they have in order that these students can be reached."

Student Spotlight: Tiffany

My name is Tiffany and I grew up with my brother in a divorced family since I was 7. My dad was Catholic and my mom didn't come back to Christ until I was 11. My brother and I also didn't get along very well. I always longed for something more than what I had at home. I also had a pessimistic view of relationships, which made it hard for others to get to know me because I never trusted anyone.



In 2014, I got involved in a youth group and attended a summer retreat where I was learned how abundant God's love is for me, despite all my brokenness. For the first time, I didn't feel empty!
