Ramiro Junior Zetina, grew up in the heart of Compton, CA. When Junior was 3 years old, his dad abandoned his mom and left her to raise Junior with his seven older siblings. In order to make ends meet, his mom had to work a full time job and the four oldest siblings had to sell roses on the side of freeway exits. By the time Junior was in 1<sup>st</sup> grade, his two brothers were actively involved in gangs. In elementary school, his house was raided by police and shot at by rival gangs multiple times. In 2<sup>nd</sup> grade, Junior remembers opening the front door to find his friend shot through the leg. After years of experiencing tragedy, Junior came to the conclusion that this life was normal and he was simply "unlucky".

When we came to Long Beach in 2013, Ramiro was one of the first students that we had met. Through a weekly Cru meeting, Junior decided to accept Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior! Since that day, Junior has been involved weekly discipleship. During his junior year, he became a student leader at Poly High School. In 2015, Ramiro became the first person in his entire family to graduate from high school! In the fall, Junior became the first person in his family to enroll in college. In the Spring of 2016, Junior became a college volunteer with Cru and raised full support to help lead a mission trip to Puerto Rica.
