SpringFest

Every Spring, Fountain Valley (FVHS) host SpringFest as an opportunity for the clubs to raise money. For Cru, we took this opportunity to share the Gospel! As always, we partnered with InterVarsity to use their "proxy station" as our evangelism tool.



We offered students a free boba tea, if they completed the station, which was simply four poster-boards arrayed around a pop-up tent. It starts off with a couple of thought-provoking questions, and ends by sharing that Jesus alone can satisfy any need or desire that we have. Through our student servant team and faithful community members, we were able to share the Gospel with over one hundred students! Out of those, 76 requested personal follow-up!

Dimitri and Mark

One encouraging story of the night came from my student Mark. Mark had shared to me that he had recently moved because his parents had divorced last month. "I'm fine", he said. Seeing that he was trying to keep a strong face, I probed deeper. "Ok, I'm not fine. This is hard!



They have been fighting all my life so I wasn't surprised. What's worse is that my friend group at school dissolved. I feel so alone when I come to school. I don't know who to sit with or hang out with..." Knowing that Dimitri's experience was similar, I asked Dimitri to share part of his story with Mark.

As conversation went on, Dimitri and Mark began to relate over the difficulty of going through a split family. "I know it's difficult Mark... but God will help you through it. He's changed my life and I see Him restoring my family through prayer." Mark smiled knowing that his pain wasn't anonymous; he wasn't alone. By the end, Mark decided to attend a weekly Bible study! While our story may be painful, it's incredible to see how God can redeem them for His glory!
