After working with inner-city kids here, I have grown to realize that even though many of our students come from broken families, the Lord continually used CRU to bring love and restoration. Through providing a sense of family that they long for, we train them to become Christ-centered laborers.

Don't you desire for your life to count, to make a difference? I do, and so I'm thankful that we have a mission that is tremendously purposeful. We have the privilege of mobilizing people to give every person on this earth a chance to hear, understand and experience the Gospel of Jesus Christ. We want students to grasp the beauty of what Christ has done and to reflect His love to people as they are sent into this world to be business leaders, doctors, missionaries, or wherever the Lord calls them. What if every student that graduated with us was sent into their next 40-50 years of life with training and a personal plan to give people a taste of that true life wherever they went? Even my weekly Bible study that started with two guys have increased to six students and one volunteer. The Lord has blessed our ministry with growth beyond anything that we could have even dreamed. Many students have come to meet our Savior and growing in their relationship with Him!

We still have much ground to cover, but we are excited about the direction that our great God has us moving. And you are part of the reason that we are seeing such tremendous progress! Because of your generosity to me, I have been able to remain in college while also staying on campus. The entire time, trusting God to turn lost students into Christ-centered laborers. I am SO thankful for you! Being at seventy percent of my goal, I am still faced with the reality that my monthly support is not where it needs to be.
