The next day, we had a day where the students could share their testimonies and also meet the CCC team. When we asked him how he was feeling, he simply responded, "I've never felt this loved before in my life."

Scotty was simply one of 1,100 students that we had conversations with in the past week. Out of those 1,100, we had 151 students indicate a decision to follow Jesus!
