#### "Joe, I went on Commando Cru last night and it changed my life" - Epic student from Smith College.

With quotes like this one, It's pretty obvious our students were pretty excited as they saw God move in ways they had never expected, never predicted and only heard in stories. But as they put their doubts on hold and they focus on God and others, God was able to use them and grow them in ways that it's hard to put into words. This year as we mentioned in our February Prayer letter, we went down to Big Break (Panam City Beach) with 46 students. 12 of whom were Epic students. It had a completely different feel for us as staff from our previous years, as the growing numbers did not allow for us to connect and shepherd each student as well as in previous years, Our faith was stretched as we had to entrust our students' Big Break experiences to God. Most of them were there for the first time and had never shared their faith before. As you might expect God was perfectly capable of blowing away our students' minds.

Aaron a Division 1 football player from UMass remembers, "When they said we were going to go on the beaches to share the gospel I was like... Yeah right, people always say they're going to share the gospel... but then I got here and I was like Oh my God! They're really going to make us do this!? And I was terrified!" But as he and so many others stepped out they found that God was already at work. And fear turned into boldness.

It was Thursday dinner time, and the Epic students at Big Break were having dinner together. Halfway into the the dinner time, as we were beginning to share about our week at Big Break so far, John, a Taiwanese student who studies Business, arrives breathless.

"Joe! Can I share?! I've got something to share! You know I went out last night to the clubs with a bunch of us and I ran into these 3 people and we started talking, I think we did the survey, and one of them wasn't so

interested. It was the girl, well there were 2 girls and a guy, but one of the girls wasn't so interested and so Lindsay and Justin stayed. Then after a bit, Justin left too. And I was just talking to Lindsay. We talked for a while, and I got to go through the Knowing God Personally booklet with her. She was totally focused, she really wanted to know how to have a personal relationship with Jesus! After that she said she'd read it again and took the booklet with her and I gave her my number in case she had any questions."

"Well today I got a call from this number I didn't recognize. I picked it up and all I could hear was crying. It was Lindsay. She told me that she went through the booklet again and that she got it. She really got it. She understood and she had just prayed to invite Jesus into her heart. That's why I was late." Praise God! But the story doesn't end there. After we got back to Amherst, John had something more to share at our weekly Epic leader's small group meeting. Apparently, Lindsay was so excited about her new relationship with the God of the universe that
