In our October 2011 prayer letter we shared with you about a young woman (freshman) who came to receive Christ. Betsy and Kayla (a staff member and a student small group leader) met with Melissa (name changed) as a follow up appointment to a lunch line survey that Melissa had filled out, on which she indicated an interest in a personal relationship with God. As part of their first conversation, Melissa invited Jesus into her life, but also was tranparent about her stuggles with same-sex attraction.

At the end of our report we asked for prayer, because shortly after she invited Jesus into her heart she began attending events sponsored by the Stonewall Center (the UMass funded LGBT education and advocacy center). At the time of our prayer letter she had stopped attending her small group bible study and was seemingly distancing herself from Cru. And so it seemed for the rest of the Fall semester.

Kayla tried to keep in touch with Melissa and from time to time was able to meet. The tone of the conversations changed radically from previous meetings. Filled with angry, hurt, doubtful, from the documentaries she watched at the Stonewall Center (http://www.umass.edu/stonewall/), Melissa had many tense questions for Kayla about how gays were viewed by God, and Christians. As time went on it seemed more and more like Melissa was slipping away.

Then one day early in the Spring semester, Melissa approached our club table in the Campus Center Concourse where thousands of students pass every day. She asked the students at the table how God felt about homosexuals. Nervous and awkwardly, Charly, a student in my small group, answered with grace and truth. Without reply Melissa left the table.

Not long after, Melissa unexpectedly showed up to our weekly meeting, and week by week she kept showing up. Eventually she joined a small group, and during the final exams week, perhaps in reply to President Obama's now public support for gay marriage, Melissa's facebook status read "I believe in biblical marriage, one man and one woman".
