\* All of the students at Big Break were trained how to share their



faith. Everyday we went out to the beach and shared the gospel with other college students who were there for Spring Break.

\* During the week we were there, students initiated over 6,000 total conversations on the beach, many times leading to an opportunity to share Christ.

\* Almost 400 students indicated a decision to trust Christ! Only time will tell if these decisions were genuine. Please pray for these young believers, that

we'd be able to follow up with them.

\* Josh (bottom left in group photo) is an int'l student at St. Louis University from Hong Kong. Tim from SLU has been friends with Josh all year and invited him to Big Break. (Tim was with us in East Asia last summer & has a heart for int'l's) Josh loved the trip to Florida and learned a lot about Christ and the claims he made. Thursday night after returning from Florida, **Josh prayed to trust his sins to Jesus while on the way home from a CRU meeting with Tim!**
