




Dear Friend, November 9, 2025

Whether we're pulling all-nighters with brothers in the struggle, training on a volleyball court, life-coaching in Christ, or following the Lord wherever He leads, we are building **together with YOU**. You are one of the main reasons we're able to keep reaching out, and we pray you truly know how valued you are.
