of the summer. Over the course of several weeks Jenna saw God move in some pretty incredible ways to work it out for her to be part of "The Summit". As Malisa was meeting with her she asked if Jenna would write down what God had done as a way to encourage others students who were wrestling with where God was leading in their lives.

*"When I first heard of the Summit Conference, the thought of spending a week strengthening and challenging my faith seemed amazing. Then there was the catch. I thought I heard an \$899 price tag. Seriously, God?"*

*"As the semester was winding down, I saw plane tickets home to Hawaii for only \$400 round trip. My roommates caught sight of it and were as ecstatic. Our talks of their visit to Hawaii were finally made into real plans, but for some reason I didn't want to buy the tickets just yet.*

*At an informational session about "The Summit", I kept thinking about how I would love to devote a week to God. However, it would be followed by the thought of being a disappointment to my friends who were looking forward to their trip to my home state. Then at the end of the info session they told everyone they dropped the price to \$299. I was torn.*

*"I made a decision. I booked a plane trip home. Round trip, actually. That's right, I booked a plane ticket travel across the country for only two weeks and to come back to Boston for "The Summit". I didn't know how I was going to pay for it.*

*"A few days after I told Malisa that I was going to the Summit, I received a call from my mother, who doesn't know Jesus. "I'm going to put \$2,100 in your account for your birthday." First off, my mother never gives me birthday presents. Second, I didn't think my parents could afford that type of gift right now. Third, my birthday isn't until July. Praise God!*

*"It's amazing how God shows up when we need Him. I tend to get caught up in trying to make God fit into my own plan and forgetting to think about His will. Although there are always reasons to pass on these opportunities, God can make it work if we follow Him. I challenge you to think about what God is calling you to do this summer. Whether it is to go home with your roommates or register for the Summit, God's got it covered. -Jenna"*

And that's a good reminder for us. **Malisa and I are in need of an additional \$1,600 in monthly financial support.** We're desperately trusting the Lord to see that support come in by July 15.
