“What do you hate about Religion?”

But how do you train someone to have sensitive conversations with their close friends about the gospel? Conversations where they listen for little windows to the soul of their friend? How do you teach them how to join their friends on their spiritual journey and point them toward Christ?

friends at two in the morning hoping for a good conversation. As a staff person with Campus Crusade for Christ, It's awkward. So we look for ways to train our students to know and share the gospel.

During March, we transformed our citywide meetings into evangelistic outreaches so we could train our students. Last week we went to BU passing out Blue Like Jazz books and asking people questions. The first question: “What do you hate about religion?” Boy did that get people talking! Our goal is to show our students how to listen and demonstrate how to point someone toward the true solution to all of life's problems: Jesus Christ.

Becca from Wentworth came to a couple of our outreaches and learned to join others on their spiritual journey and point them toward Christ. Here's what she said about the experience: “The more I share the gospel with strangers, the more I talk with my

friends. This week I shared with my friends so many times it was obscene!”

That's why I'm doing what

I'm doing. Not only do I get a chance to have great conversations and share the gospel, the students I work with get a heart for the lost and talk about Jesus with everyone they meet.
