My alarm went off at 6 am and up I (Malisa) went into the kitchen to make breakfast for 25 students who we had invited to an overnight leadership weekend. 3 dozen eggs later and I was waking up the girls who had slept right through their alarm clock last Saturday morning. It might have had something to do with the fact that they were all up until around 2:30am. What else do college students do on Friday nights? Well, this weekend was a bit of a different one for Sadiyah. Sadiyah is a freshman from Babson college. I first met Sadiyah when her friend brought her to our house for a Friday night pizza party about six weeks ago (We actually asked you to pray for that night in

our February prayer letter) Three days later, she heard a clear presentation of the Gospel and for the first time wanted to begin a new life, a relationship with Jesus. Wow, what a sweet picture of God working through the power of community. Every week Sadiyah has been eagerly coming to a small group bible study where I get to encourage and help the girls understand what it means to walk with Jesus. This past weekend, Sadiyah, even as brand new believer, was part of that group of 25 student leaders. Over breakfast they discussed what it looks like to be a disciple of Christ, what it looks like to deeply love your neighbors, and how to trust God for what he might want to do on campus to reach more of their friends with the Gospel. She was beaming ear to ear every time I looked at her. This is a "newness of Life thing" for Sadiyah. As I was spending time with Jesus this morning I was reminded that "We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of Life."
