On Saturday night, Jason sat down at the table with me and some other students. As freshmen and transfer students, they were new to college in Boston. And they were sharing that there was a limited number of things that were “OK” to share about as students. And Jesus was certainly not on that list. They knew intrinsically that they it was politically/socially incorrect to talk about Jesus with their friends at School. It would be way too awkward.

“I’m really glad people pressed through the awkward with me,” Jason said.

Now, Jason is a senior. “This weekend, I finally decided to become a Christian and to ask Jesus into my life.” Jason told the group of us at our Fall Retreat.
