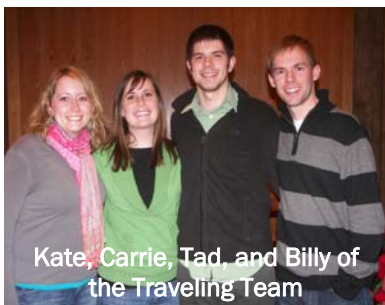

### ***Evangelism Night***

We had spent every week *talking about* evangelism. So, during one of our weekly meetings we thought we'd have the students actually *doing* evangelism.

For practical application, we paired the students up, and we sent them out to the mission field of their very own campus to interact with other peers about spiritual matters. We used two evangelism tools: spiritual surveys and a tool called Soularium, to

start spiritual conversations with students around campus. The purpose of both of these tools are to get into spiritual conversations with other people with the hope of sharing the Gospel. The students returned to the weekly meeting the following week to share their experiences with evangelism. After hearing many of the students' experiences, there seemed to be a genuine excitement for sharing the Gospel. One particular student, Ryan said, "You never know what part of the Gospel is going to hit someone" as he encouraged his friends to be bold in their faith. At the end of the meeting Ryan prayed, "God, thank you for using us to share your Good News. Open the hearts of this campus."
