Yellowstone Summer Project 2010

This year our summer ministry assignment takes us back to the place where Nate clearly sensed God's calling in his life to full-time college ministry, Yellowstone National Park (YNP). Nate had the opportunity to attend this summer project as a student in 2004. It's hard to believe it's been 6 years! We will be co-leading a team of 16 students who will be working at Old Faithful Inn in YNP. This summer project is unique in that students actually have jobs and their primary ministry focus is their fellow co-workers, many of which are college students from around the world. Students will learn to listen, share their faith story, and to communicate the Gospel in numerous settings throughout their daily and weekly activities!



The dates for the summer project are May 29th–August 14th. As staff, we will only be there for the first 5 weeks to help the students learn and understand the different ministries that will take place over the summer. Those ministries include 'Faith groups' that will be setup in the dorms where students can invite their co-workers to come and investigate what it means to follow Christ, bi-weekly bonfire outreaches, and many other outreaches related to hiking, backpacking...etc. Please pray that God would use this summer to draw us and our students closer to Him, and that God would work in the hearts of the people we will meet to bring them into a relationship with Him.
