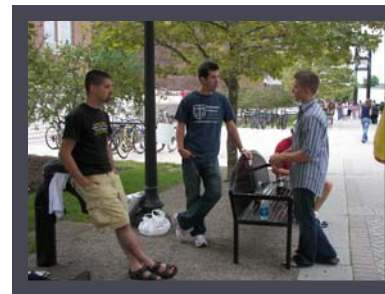
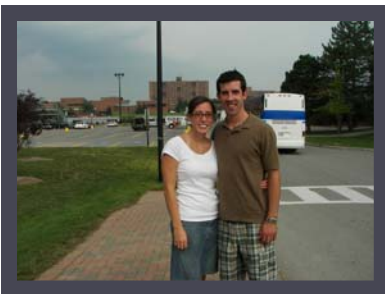


Back To School...A New Perspective
